

DALLAS ANIMAL SERVICES COMMUNITY CAT PROGRAM

If you are a caretaker or trapper of feral and community cats, the City of Dallas subsidizes spay/neuter, vaccinations, microchip, and ear-tipping services at no cost to city of Dallas residents with a **Service Request number**. Here are the options you have to get un-owned cats in our city fixed and vaccinated:

WHAT IS A COMMUNITY CAT?

Community cats are outdoor cats in our neighborhoods that may be friendly or unsocialized. These cats may or may not have a caretaker.

SERVICE REQUEST NUMBERS

Residents of the city of Dallas can obtain a Service Request number through the 3-1-1 reporting system.

Option 1: Call 3-1-1 and ask for a SR number for community cats.

Option 2: Download the Our Dallas mobile app through the App Store or Google Play.

Option 3: Use the online form at <https://dallascrm.my.site.com/public/s/> or scan the QR code.

HOW LONG DOES MY SR NUMBER LAST FOR?

You can reuse your SR number for up to a year. Only one SR number is needed per address (not per cat).

MONTHLY FIX EVENTS

Please check BeDallas90.org/events for rescheduling or cancellations in case of holidays or inclement weather.



On the first Thursday of each month, you can bring cats to Dallas Animal Services (1818 North Westmoreland Road) and Spay Neuter Network will pick them up for surgery.

- Only 60 cats will be accepted.
- Check-in is at 7:00 a.m. Pick up is at 5:00 p.m.
- No limit on cats per trapper.
- Both humane traps and hard-sided carriers are accepted.
- Includes spay/neuter, ear tip, microchip, FVRCP, rabies, and post-op pain management.



On the last Wednesday of each month, you can bring cats to Operation Kindness' Lifesaving Partnerships Hub (1771 Terre Colony Ct., Dallas, TX 75212).

- Up to 75 cats will be accepted.
- Check-in is at 7:00 a.m. Pick up is at 3:30 p.m.
- No limit on cats per trapper.
- Cats must be in a humane trap; one cat per trap.
- Includes spay/neuter, ear tip, microchip, FVRCP, rabies, and post-op pain management.

WALK-IN CLINICS



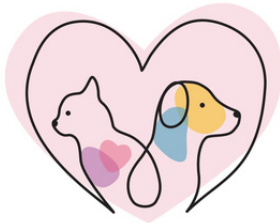
Spay Neuter Network accepts as many cats as the day's schedule allows on a first-come-first-served basis Tuesday - Friday at their Dallas (2223 S Buckner Blvd, suite 203, Dallas, TX 75227) and Crandall (102 East Trunk Street Crandall, TX 75114) locations.

- Limit of two (2) cats per trapper
- Check-in is at 9:00 a.m. Please do not arrive more than 20 minutes early.
- Pick up is at 4:30 p.m.
- Both humane traps and hard-sided carriers are accepted.
- Includes spay/neuter, ear tip, microchip, FVRCP, rabies, and post-op pain shot



TCAP accepts up to 12 cats per day on each of their eight (8) locations on their designated community cat surgery days. Visit texasforthem.org for details.

- Limit of four (4) cats per trapper
- Check-in is at 8:00 a.m. Please arrive early! Pick up is at 3 p.m.
- Cats must be in a humane trap; one cat per trap.
- Includes spay/neuter, ear tip, microchip, FHCPC, rabies, and post-op pain shot



SPAY NEUTER

Spay Neuter Society will accept up to 10 walk-in feral cats on a first-come-first-served basis Monday - Thursday at their Lewisville clinic (1260 W Round Grove Road #400, Lewisville TX 75067).

- Trappers should arrive by 8 a.m., check-in will cut off at 9 a.m. or once all 10 spots have been filled. Pick up is at 3 p.m., no later than 4 p.m.
- Cats must be in a humane trap; one cat per trap. Cover trap with a towel or sheet.
- To expedite the check-in process, trappers may email spayneutersociety@gmail.com ahead of time with their SR contact information, and anticipated drop-off date.
- Includes spay/neuter, ear tip, tattoo, microchip, FVRCP, rabies, and post-op pain shot

CAN DAS HELP SICK OR INJURED COMMUNITY CATS?

YES. Make a report through 311, select the option for Animal Care & Control, and Animal Lack of Care.
